Multiple Felony Drug Charges in the Village of Endicott

(ENDICOTT, NY) Two Endicott residents are facing multiple felony drug charges after the Broome County Special Investigations Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant this week.

The Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant at 403 Jackson Ave in the Village of Endicott. Located at the residence were Steven V. Masciarelli, age 53 of Endicott and Ann M. Forkey, age 54 of Endicott. During the execution of the search warrant, the following items of evidence were located:

- 6.1 Grams of Methamphetamine
- A Quantity of Fentanyl
- Psilocybin Mushrooms
- Scales and packaging materials used for weighing and packaging narcotics for sale

Following the investigation, Steven V. Masciarelli was charged with the following:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5th Degree, a Class D Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Two counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

Ann M. Forkey was charged with:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5th Degree, a Class D Felony
- Two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A
