Families who qualify for low income distribution program may be eligible to receive a free child safety seat (WIC ID, DSS ID or referral from agency that assists income-eligible families). To the appointment, parent or legal guardian must bring the child, their driver's license, vehicle that the seat will remain in, vehicle owner's manual. Expectant parents should call at least one month prior to delivery date. Inspection sites by appointment only.
