

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The Committee meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 4:15 PM. Mr. Marinich moved the agenda, seconded by Mr. Merrill. The Committee took the following action with regard to the matters before it:

#1 RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR NON-UNION ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011

Carried. Ayes-4, Nays-1 (Marinich)

Mr. Klein explained that the employees in these positions did not receive any increase in 2010 and they do not have the benefit of unions negotiating raises for them. There are some instances where lower grade CSEA Clerks are making more money than Admin I Clerks at a higher grade. The resolution reflects a 2% increase which was included in the 2011 budget.
