Broome County Clerk Aaron Martin Announces Department of Motor Vehicles to Temporarily Suspend In-Person Services

Binghamton, NY – Broome County Clerk Aaron Martin announced that due to a New York State Department of Motor Vehicles software system update, the Endicott DMV office will not open to the public on Saturday, February 21st, 2026. Earlier this week, a new, modernized software system was installed to improve customer service and streamline operations for both customers and DMV staff. Additional updates to the system are expected to occur over the upcoming weekend which will impact the DMV staff's ability to process transactions for customers. Both the Endicott and Binghamton DMV offices will resume normal hours of service on Monday, February 23rd, 2026 at 8:00 AM.

Further, the temporary suspension of mobile DMV services will be extended through Friday, February 27th, 2026. Mobile DMV services are expected to resume on Monday, March 2nd, 2026.
