APPLICATION FEE WAIVER: A waiver of application fee will be allowed if you are unemployed and primarily responsible for the support of a household. In addition, a waiver of application fee will be allowed if you are determined eligible for Medicaid, or receiving Supplemental Security Income payments, or Public Assistance (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families/Family Assistance or Safety Net Assistance) or are certified Job Training Partnership Act/Workforce Investment Act eligible through a State or local social service agency. Eligible list: Successful candidates will be certified to fill vacancies only in the department in which they are employed.

\*\*Vacancies- Positions may be filled temporarily at this time; however, the resulting eligible list must be used to permanently fill the position.

**DUTIES:** The work involves responsibility for overseeing the development, maintenance and operation of a Geographic Information System (GIS). The duties vary according to assignment; however, in general, the incumbent assists the conversion of digital and non-digital data to a GIS based system and the ongoing modifications, maintenance and operation of the system. The incumbent also performs other related professional or technical duties specific to the assignment such as planning activities, creating and processing requests for maps, and/or maintaining a computer network. This class differs from Geographic Information System Technician in that a Geographic Information System Specialist performs a greater scope of duties, has greater independence of action and has overall responsibility for a Geographic Information System. The work is performed under the general supervision of a department head and/or GIS Administrator with considerable leeway allowed for exercising independent judgment in carrying out the details of the work. Does related work as required.

**PROMOTIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:** On or before the date of the examination, candidates must be permanently employed in the competitive class (or designated as non-competitive in accordance with Section 55A of Civil Service Law) in the GIS Technician position and must have served continuously on a permanent or contingent permanent basis for 24 months preceding the date of the written test as a GIS Technician with the Broome County Department of Planning.

# Anticipated eligibility: If you expect to meet the promotional qualifications by <u>December 28, 2025</u>, you will be tentatively admitted to this examination.

## Special Requirement for Appointment in School Districts and BOCES

Per Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, to be employed in a position designated by a school district or BOCES as involving direct contact with students, a clearance for employment from the State Education Department is required.

#### SUBJECT OF EXAMINATION: A test designed to evaluate knowledge, skills and /or abilities in the following areas.

#### Preparing written material

These questions test for the ability to present information clearly and accurately, and to organize paragraphs logically and comprehensibly. For some questions, you will be given information in two or three sentences followed by four restatements of the information. You must then choose

the best version. For other questions, you will be given paragraphs with their sentences out of order. You must then choose, from four suggestions, the best order for the sentences.

Understanding and interpreting maps, aerial photography, survey data, and other source material used in map construction

These questions test for the ability to read, analyze, and perform computations based on cartographic drawings, site plans, survey notes, and mapping-related written presentations, and for knowledge of the terminology and principles involved in reading and working with aerial photographs, including scale conversion and focal point computations.

Collection, analysis, and presentation of data, including basic statistics

These questions test for knowledge of the proper procedures and methods used to gather, evaluate, organize, and present various types of technical data and information, and the fundamental concepts, terminology, and computations involved in statistical analysis for cartographic and land use planning studies.

Geographic Information Systems (GIS), including data conversion, plotting, database construction, interactive editing, and labeling These questions test for knowledge of GIS design features, global positioning systems, and the concepts, terminology, and proper procedures to use when creating, producing, and revising various types of maps and site plans using GIS and computerized mapping software. Principles of data bases for PC's

These questions test for a basic background in the design and use of data bases on microcomputers. They cover such topics as data base terminology and concepts, analyzing a data base project, planning the data base, organizing the data, designing data entry forms, accessing and manipulating the data, generating reports, and performing backups.

The New York State Department of Civil Service <u>has not</u> prepared a test guide for this examination. However, candidates may find information in the publication "How to take a written test" helpful in preparing for this test. Candidates must bring their picture ID and two sharpened #2 pencils to the examination. **USE OF CALCULATORS IS ALLOWED FOR THIS EXAMINATION**. Devices with typewriter keyboards, spell checkers, personal digital assistants, address books, language translators, dictionaries, or any similar devices are prohibited.

**Seniority Credit:** Seniority is based on the length of continuous permanent classified service in the jurisdiction in which promotion is sought, with points added to an eligible's passing score for each appropriate five year period or fraction thereof in accordance with the following schedule:

Less than 1 year0 points	Over 11 years up to 16 years
1 year up to 6 years1 point	Over 16 years up to 21 years4 points
Over 6 years up to 11 years2 points	Over 21 years5 points

**Rating:** The written examination is being prepared and rated by the New York State Department of Civil Service, in accordance with Section 23-2 of the Civil Service Law. The provisions of the New York State Civil Service Rules and Regulations dealing with the rating of examinations will apply to this written test.

## Applying for civil service examinations in multiple jurisdictions when examinations are scheduled on same date:

If you have **applied** for both a Broome County examination and an examination for another jurisdiction, both of which are scheduled for the same date, you must submit a Broome County Cross-filing Form indicating the site at which you intend to take your examination. The cross-filing form is available in our Department or online at <a href="http://gobroomecounty.com/files/personnel/pdfs/Crossfiling.pdf">http://gobroomecounty.com/files/personnel/pdfs/Crossfiling.pdf</a> and should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the examinations. Failure to submit the Crossfiling form in a timely manner may result in our not being able to accommodate your request to sit at your choice of exam sites. When taking both a State and Broome County examination, you will be required to take all your examinations at a State examination center. You will be advised by the State when and where to report for your examinations.

**Religious accommodation/handicapped candidates/military personnel:** If special arrangements for testing are required, indicate this on your application form.

Military Law provides special rights for members of the armed forces whose military service conflicts with scheduled civil service testing. Section 243-b (2) of Military Law states that "any member of the organized militia or reserves, who, because of active military duty other than for training purposes, missed the application filing period for an examination and as a result is deprived of the opportunity to compete in an examination, shall be given a special military make-up exam". Please contact the Department of Personnel for more information.

**Children of Firefighters and Police Officers killed in the line of duty:** "In conformance with section 85-A of the Civil Service Law, children of firefighters and police officers killed in the line of duty shall be entitled to receive an additional ten points in a competitive examination for original appointment in the same municipality in which his or her parent has served. If you are qualified to participate in this examination and are a child of a firefighter or police officer killed in the line of duty in this municipality, please inform the Department of Personnel of this matter when you submit your application for examination. A candidate claiming such credit has a minimum of two months from the application deadline to provide the necessary documentation to verify additional credit eligibility. However, no credit may be added after the eligible list has been established."
