ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT WORKER

DISTINGUISHING THE FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under the general supervision of a higher level administrator, this position involves responsible maintenance and repair of a wide variety of athletic and physical education equipment, indoor and outdoor facilities and playing fields, courts and grounds. Responsibility may include the operation of the laundry room. Guidance may be given to a small number of student helpers. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Stores, inventories, maintains, repairs and cleans equipment and uniforms used in the athletic and physical education departments;

Dispenses equipment, uniforms, towels and other supplies to athletes and physical education participants;

Assembles equipment and apparatus for use in both classes and sporting events;

Maintains, cleans and repairs both indoor and outdoor sports facilities and grounds;

May order supplies;

May operate laundry facilities and mend uniforms and supplies.

Good knowledge of the layout and maintenance procedures of various sport facilities;

Ability to build and repair a wide range of athletic and physical education equipment;

Ability to work from rough sketches;

Ability to get along will with other;

Good condition;
