Barbara J. Fiala, County Executive:

The Department of Audit and Control has compiled a summary of the status of accounts receivable balances in various County departments as of March 31, 2005.

Our analysis of the data provided has revealed the following critical issues:

- The Aviation Accounts Receivable aging shows two (2) amounts outstanding over 90 days. Piedmont Airlines owes \$41,528.63 and PSA Airlines owes \$5,020.70. According to the Aviation Department, both of these companies are presently involved in bankruptcy proceedings, leaving the Aviation Department unable to pursue collection.
- The Solid Waste Division's over 90 day category shows a 99% increase. However, 35% of this balance was paid after the quarter ended and will be reflected in the next report.

Attached are schedules summarizing the status of significant receivables as of March 31, 2005. The criteria that we established for monitoring was to track balances that were in excess of \$100,000 as of March 31, 2005 and generate from fee for service transactions. If you are aware of other receivable categories that are at risk of becoming uncollectable, please advise.
