Binghamton High School (Host Team) - Patriots

Binghamton, New York David Springer - HC

Last season the Patriots won the Metro Division Title. The Patriots have won 12 STAC and 11 Sectional Championships since 1982. The Patriots were the New York State Class A Champions in 1985 and 1986. David Springer is entering his 7th season as head coach and has a record of 95-37.

Players to Watch: Returning Seniors Bruno Saraceno, Matt Papso and Scott Valenta. Junior Varsity finished 18-2 and won STAC.

Bishop Ford Central Catholic High School - Falcons
