***County Clerk Mihalko and the Greater Binghamton Chamber of Commerce Announce a Gift Card Promotion in Partnership with Michelangelo's Pizzeria and Restaurant***

County Clerk Joseph Mihalko, the Greater Binghamton Chamber of Commerce (GBCC) and Michelangelo's Pizzeria and Restaurant are partnering to encourage local residents to use local DMV services. All driver's license renewals and vehicle registration renewals that are dropped off at one of the six DMV "drop boxes" around the County or that are mailed in to the Binghamton DMV (81 Chenango Street, Binghamton, NY 13901) in August will be eligible to be entered into a drawing for a \$50 gift card to Michelangelo's Pizzeria (465 Court St, Binghamton, NY 13904). The winner will be drawn randomly and announced in early September.

"Currently, only about 40% of all DMV transactions are processed in our local offices," explained County Clerk Mihalko. "The fee to renew a standard Class D driver's license is \$64.50, whether you do so online, by mail or in person. But when you renew locally, 12.7% of that fee stays in Broome County to help pay for essential local government services. That money goes straight into New York's bloated General Fund when you renew online or mail your documents to Albany. I'm proudly partnering with the Greater Binghamton Chamber and Michelangelo's to encourage folks to renew locally and to support our outstanding locally-owned restaurants and businesses here in Broome County."

"The Greater Binghamton Chamber of Commerce has been promoting a 'Buy in Broome' campaign to help local businesses succeed," said GBCC Senior Vice President Amy Shaw. "We enthusiastically support the County Clerk's local DMV services initiative and applaud the owners of Michelangelo's for their generous donation of a \$50 gift card to help further the County's cause."

The six DMV "drop boxes" are located at:

- the Broome County Office Building at 60 Hawley Street in Binghamton
- the Broome West Senior Center at 2801 Wayne Street in Endwell
- the Eastern Broome Senior Center at 27 Golden Lane in Harpursville
- the First Ward Senior Center at 226 Clinton Street in Binghamton
- the Johnson City Senior Center at 30 Brocton Street in Johnson City
- the Northern Broome Senior Center at 12 Strongs Place in Whitney Point

Before you renew your driver's license or vehicle registration online, or mail it in to New York State, please consider using one of Broome County's six DMV "drop boxes" or our renewal by mail program, so you can be entered into the drawing.
