RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF THE COMPUTER PROGRAMMER ANALYST SUPPORT PROGRAM GRANT FOR DIVISION OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND **ADOPTING A PROGRAM BUDGET FOR 2017** 

WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 430 of 2015, authorized and approved renewal of the Computer Programmer Analyst Support Program Grant for the Division of Information Technology and adopted a program budget in the amount of \$114,826 for the period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, and

WHEREAS, said program grant allows for a person to support the Willow Point Nursing Home for emergency preparedness, disaster planning and application support, and

WHEREAS, it is desired to renew said program grant in the amount of \$114,967 for the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorized and approved funding in the amount of \$23,000 from the Willow Point Nursing and \$91,967 from the Division of Information Technology for the Division of Information Technology's Computer Programmer Analyst Support Program Grant for the period January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2017, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby approves and adopts the program budget annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" in the total amount of \$114,967, and be it

WHEREAS, it has been the practice of the Broome County Legislature to appoint Board of Election Commissioners to four year terms, and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Broome County Democrat Committee has filed with the Clerk of this Legislature, on behalf of the Broome County Democrat Committee and in compliance with the appropriate provisions of law, the required certificate recommending the appointment of Philip K. Grommet, to serve as a Commissioner of Elections for Broome County, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with the appropriate provisions of law, and the Broome County Charter and Administrative Code, Philip K. Grommet, residing at 32 Brookfield Road, Binghamton, New York 13903, be and hereby is appointed Democrat Election Commissioner of Broome County, New York for a four year term commencing January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2020.
