WHEREAS, RFP 2017-013 Airport Advertising Concession for the Greater Binghamton Airport was issued, and

WHEREAS, as a result of said RFP the Commissioner of Aviation requests authorization for an agreement with <u>Bosanne Sall Advertising</u>. Inc. for professional advertising marketing services at the Greater Binghamton Airport for the Department of Aviation for the period April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, with the option for three one-year renewals under the same terms and conditions, and

WHEREAS, said agreement is necessary for Airport Advertising Concession for the Greater Binghamton Airport, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes an agreement with <u>Rosanne Sall</u> <u>Advertising</u>, <u>Inc.</u>, <u>88 Main Street</u>, <u>Binghamton</u>, <u>New York 13905</u>, for professional advertising services at the Greater Binghamton Airport for the Department of Aviation for the period April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, with the option for three one-year renewals under the same terms and conditions, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said services, the County shall receive 60% of net billings for the term of the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue hereinabove authorized shall be credited to budget line 210070.0103.207000 (Advertising Fees), and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or their duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
