

PUBLIC WORKS & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Ms. Boulton stated that when the County was the only occupant of the Hillcrest Depot, the Federal Government paid the electric bills. Several years ago, the Federal Government sold a portion of the Depot to Carrier Services and they began paying the entire electric bill, including the County's portion. The County would like to reimburse Carrier for the usage of electric and will pay their portion going forward.
