The Chair introduced Stephanie Jerzak who has recently taken on the role of Deputy Nursing Home Administrator of Fiscal Services. Deputy County Executive of Physical Services Michael Ponticello stated that this resolution brings the County in line with a routine annual write-off. In response to a question from the Committee, Mr. Ponticiello stated that this resolution writes off the amounts from an accounting standpoint. It was also stated that Medicaid and Medicare payments are supposed to be guaranteed payments if they are correctly submitted, but the nursing facilities need to regularly apply and re-apply for reimbursement due to the intricacies of the application and payment process. The Chair introduced Scott Montgomery from Greater Opportunities who discussed programs geared toward Veterans and housing for Veterans.
