## NOTICE OF FORMATION OF AD HOC INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE BROOME COUNTY LEGISLATURE

Whereas, the County Legislature has in the past had as a standing committee known as the Intergovernmental Relations (IGR) Committee, which standing committee was terminated, and

Whereas, County and municipal officials have expressed a desire to renew this committee, in some form, in order to provide a forum for regular discussion of county issues that have an effect on municipal governments

Therefore, in consideration of the above reasons and by powers granted in the County Charter, the Chairman of the Legislature hereby establishes an ad hoc committee on Intergovernmental Relations as set forth herein.

- 1.) The committee herein established shall be known as the Intergovernmental Relations Ad Hoc Committee.
- 2.) Said Committee shall hold regular meetings, at least on a quarterly basis.
- 3.) Notice of committee meetings shall be given by the Chairman of the Legislature to all members of the Legislature on seven days notice.
- 4.) Meetings shall be held at the County Office Building or at such other place as agreed upon by the members.
- 5.) The purpose of the committee shall be to discuss county issues, resolutions, and local laws that may affect the constituent municipalities of the County or other issues of common concern and to seek ways in which the County and municipalities can work together to deliver services in the most efficient and cost effect manner possible.
- 6.) The committee shall consist of six members of the Legislature (five Legislators plus the Chairman), who will meet with a like number of municipal representatives, which members may be appointed by the president of the Broome County Associations of Towns and Villages or otherwise as agreed by the municipal leaders.
- 7.) The following individuals are hereby appointed as County Legislative representatives to the Committee

Donald T. Moran, (12<sup>th</sup> District)

Richard A. Materese, (14th District)

Barry L. Klipsch, (18<sup>th</sup> District)
