WHEREAS, said services are necessary for construction inspection and management services for the Runway 16/34 Rehabilitation Project, now, therefore, be it



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO CONTRACT WITH SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITHIN BROOME COUNTY FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS AND AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM GRANT, AND ADOPTING A PROGRAM BUDGET FOR 2016-2017

WHEREAS, the District Attorney requests authorization to contract with school districts in Broome County for District Attorney's Investigators to work within schools as School Resource Officers (SRO) to promote safety and provide law enforcement services, and

WHEREAS, said Investigators (a/k/a SROs) will be classified as part-time District Attorney's Investigators, who on days when school is not in session, during school breaks, and during the summer, said Investigators will work on other matters within the District Attorney's Office, and

WHEREAS, the positions will pay \$25.18876 per hour, with the exact hours and days of the week to be determined by each school district with a total not to exceed \$40,000 per year to which the school districts will fund 100% of the positions, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney also requests authorization to create the District Attorney School Resource Officer Program Grant for the Office of the District Attorney to fund the School Resource Officer Program and adopting a program budget in the amount of \$200,000 for the period October 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes the District Attorney to contract with school districts in Broome County for District Attorney's Investigators to work within schools as School Resource Officers (SRO) to promote safety and provide law enforcement services through memorandum of understandings with each individual school district that wishes to participate in the program, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Investigators (a/k/a SROs) will be classified as part-time District Attorney's Investigators, who on days when school is not in session, during school breaks, and during the summer, said Investigators will work on other matters within the District Attorney's Office, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, the positions will pay \$25.18876 per hour, with the exact hours and days of the week to be determined by each school district with a total not to exceed \$40,000 per year to which the school districts will fund 100% of the positions, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that this County Legislature hereby authorizes the creation of the District Attorney School Resource Officer Program Grant, for the Office of the District Attorney for the period October 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby approves and adopts the program budget annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" in the total amount of \$200,000 and be it

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF THE COMPUTER HARDWARE TECHNICIAN PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE DIVISION OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND ADOPTING A PROGRAM BUDGET FOR 2016-2017

WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 418 of 2015, authorized and approved renewal of the Computer Hardware Technician Program Grant for the Division of Information Technology and adopted a program budget in the amount of \$84,439 for the period June 22, 2015 through August 28, 2016, and

WHEREAS, said program grant provides funding for a Computer Hardware Technician at the Office of Emergency Services to support the needs of police, fire and ambulance mobile units, and

WHEREAS, it is desired to renew said program grant in the amount of \$75,757,37 for the period August 29, 2016 through August 27, 2017, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes and approves acceptance of \$75,757.37 from the Broome County Office of Emergency Services, for the Division of Information Technology's Computer Hardware Technician Program Grant for the period August 29, 2016 through August 27, 2017, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby approves and adopts the program budget annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" in the total amount of \$75,757.37, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or her duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or her duly authorized representative is hereby empowered (with the approval of the grantor agency) to reduce the time period of the grant provided there is no change in the grant budget or extend the terms of the grant agreement for the purpose of expending any unexpended grant funds, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or her duly authorized representative (including the Director of Management and Budget and/or Comptroller) is hereby authorized to make any transfers of funds required within this grant budget provided that employee head count is not increased, the County's contribution is not increased, and the salary rate or salary total for a position is not changed.
