


Town of Barker, New York Aging Demographics Fact Sheet



In 1990, residents age 60+ made up 13.4% of the Town of Barker population. The 2016 Census data estimates that residents age 60+ made up 21.8% of the Town of Barker population. Between 1990 and 2016 the 60+ population increased by 61%.

2. Total Age Group Population Change 1990 to 2016




Chart 1: In the Town of Barker, the aging population increased from 365 in 1990 to 588 in 2016 (61% increase from 1990-2016).
