

Town of Maine, New York Aging Demographics Fact Sheet



In 1990, residents age 60+ made up 14.9% of the Town of Maine population. The 2016 Census data estimates that residents 60+ made up 24.5% of the Town of Maine population. Between 1990 and 2016 the 60+ population increased by 55.6%.




Chart 1: In the Town of Maine, the aging population has increased from 835 in 1990 to 1,299 in 2016 (55.6% increase).
