**Meth, Synthetic Cannabis and Cash Seized in Town of Fenton**

(TOWN OF FENTON) A Town of Fenton man is facing five felony drug charges following an investigation by the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force (SIU).

On March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025 The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task executed a search warrant at 450 Route 369 Lot 35 in the Town of Fenton.

During the search, the following items of evidence were recovered.

- Approximately 68.5 grams of methamphetamine
- Approximately 381 grams of a synthetic cannabinoid
- Digital scales
- Packaging material
- \$2,508 in US Currency

As a result of the search warrant, Fred W. Montgomery, age 53 of the Town of Fenton, was arrested and charged with:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a Class A-II Felony
- Two (2) Counts Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Class B Felonies
- Two (2) Counts Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5<sup>th</sup> Degree, Class D Felonies
- Two (2) Counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

Montgomery was arraigned and remains in custody at the Broome County Sheriff's Correctional Facility.
