Smith, Jr., age 39 of Endicott, NY, was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (Previous Conviction Within 10 years), a Class E Felony, Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the 1st Degree, a Class E Felony, and Criminal Contempt in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, following a traffic stop in the Village of Endicott.

George P. Waldron, age 29 of Lisle, NY, was charged with Bail Jumping in the 2nd Degree, a Class E Felony and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, following a warrant execution in the Town of Nanticoke.

Brad T. Williams, age 34, was charged with two (2) counts of Petit Larceny, Class A Misdemeanors, following separate larceny investigations in the Town of Union.

Jordan C. Wilson, age 20 of Dickinson, NY, was charged with three (3) counts of Use of a Child in a Sexual Performance, Class C Felonies, three (3) counts of Promoting an Obscene Sexual Performance by a Child, Class D Felonies Rape in the 2nd Degree (Victim under 15 years), a Class D Felony, three (3) counts of Possession an Obscene Sexual Performance by a Child, Class E Felonies and Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Class A Misdemeanor, following an investigation into statutory rape in the Town of Colesville.
