

**SIU PRESS RELEASE: Four facing felony drug charges
after search warrant execution in the Town of Chenango**

PRESS RELEASE

April 14, 2026

Four individuals are facing felony drug charges following a search warrant execution in the Town of Chenango.

On April 10th, 2026, The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force (SIU), with the assistance of the Southern Tier SWAT Team, executed a narcotics search warrant at 133 W. Chenango Rd in the Town of Chenango.

During a search of the residence the following items were located:

- Approximately 19 grams of Methamphetamine
- A quantity of fentanyl
- Suboxone strips
- Illegal steroids
- Narcotics packaging material
- Digital scale

Following the investigation, four individuals were arrested and charged with the following:

Brett J. Poyer, age 37 of the Town of Chenango, NY:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C Felony.
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

Cassandra F. Angulas, age 36 of the Town of Chenango, NY:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C Felony.
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

Jack E. Langland, age 45 of Endicott, NY:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C Felony.
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

Daisy A. Odell, age 37 of Wilesyville, NY:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the Binghamton Police Department, the Johnson City Police Department and the Endicott Police Department.
