**One man arrested after Firearms and Cocaine located**  
**during Town of Union search warrant**

(TOWN OF UNION, NY) A Town of Union man faces multiple felony drug and weapons charges following a warrant execution by the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force (SIU).

On May 9, 2025 SIU executed a search warrant at 2 Donald St. Apt.2 in the Town of Union. As a result of the search warrant, the following items of evidence were located in the apartment.

- Approximately 3.4 grams of Cocaine
- Digital Scales
- Packaging Material
- Cutting Agent
- A Ruger .45 Caliber Revolver
- A Kel-Tec 9mm Handgun

Following the investigation, Gary W. Lanzo, age 35 of the Town of Union, was arrested and charged with the following:

- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, a Class B Felony
- Three (3) Counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Class A Misdemeanors
- Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a Class C Felony
- Two (2) Counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Class D Felonies

Lanzo was arraigned and remanded to the Broome County Correctional Facility, where he remains in custody.
