Broome County Sheriff's Office Invites Public to Design Logo for 'Pink Patch Project'
Fundraiser for Local Families Fighting Cancer

(TOWN OF DICKINSON) Broome County Sheriff's Corrections Officers and Deputies are once again going pink during Breast Cancer Awareness Month, but this year, they're inviting the public to help design the new logo and t-shirt for this year's Pink Patch Project fundraiser.

The Pink Patch Project is a national campaign bringing law enforcement and the community together to raise breast cancer awareness and funding to help local families fighting cancer. With 1 in 8 women in the US at risk of developing breast cancer, it's an issue that effects every community.

Last year, Corrections Officer Jennifer McPeek brought the project to the Broome County Sheriff's Office. Throughout October 2023, over 80 members of the Broome County Sheriff's Corrections and Road Patrol divisions sported pink badges and patches and helped raise funds for local families battling cancer. Community members also lent their support to the Project by visiting the online store to purchase a t-shirt, sweatshirt, patch, or other items.

With the combined support of community members and sworn officers in both the Law Enforcement and Corrections Divisions, the Pink Patch Project raised over \$4,500 for the Community Foundation and Tina Fund. The proceeds went toward assisting local families fighting cancer by assisting with groceries, childcare or other expenses related to the fight against cancer.

"The response and support from the community and our team here at the Broome County Sheriff's Office has been wonderful," said McPeek, to project's organizer. "This year we're hoping to raise even more funds this year and we're asking the community to help us design the official Broome County Pink Patch Project Logo."
