

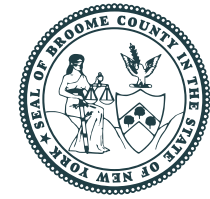


DID YOU KNOW?

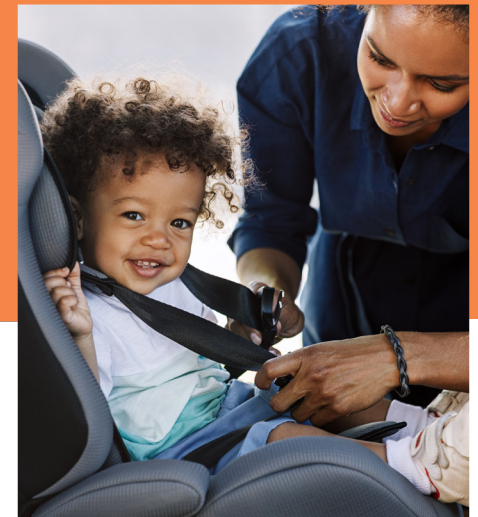
- Car seats expire. Most car seats will expire after 6 years from the date of the manufacture. Check the stickers!
- Be careful when using second-hand used car seats or car seats purchased from garage sales or flea markets. The car seat may be unsafe if you do not know its history.
- Always follow the instructions in the car seat manual AND in your vehicle manual for proper installation and harnessing.
- Be sure to register your newly purchased car seat so you can be notified of future recalls.

NEW YORK STATE LAW:

All children must be restrained in an appropriate child restraint system while riding in a motor vehicle until they reach their 8th birthday.

Effective November 1, 2019, all children under the age of 2 must ride in a rear-facing car seat. If the child has outgrown an infant seat, it is recommended that a larger, rear-facing convertible or all-in-one car seat with higher rear-facing height and weight limits be used.

An appropriate child restraint system is one that meets your child's size and weight recommended by the manufacturer. Seat belts are NOT designed for children.

CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY PROGRAMS:

Fitting Stations:

Parents and caregivers can call any of the listed fitting stations to schedule an appointment with a Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician. Technicians will provide education and guidance about the safest way to transport your child, focusing on proper selection, harnessing and installation of the child safety seat. These services are FREE to parents and caregivers.

Child Safety Seat Education & Distribution Program:

Provides free seats to parents and caregivers with economic hardships. Qualifying participants must watch an educational video online and complete a short survey prior to receiving their seat. Clients must also participate in an instructional hands-on appointment with a Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician and demonstrate the proper use of their seat before leaving.
