

- Town Of Windsor makes up roughly 2.84 % of the total Population


Countywide Calls For Service 2022-2025












Total Calls By Priority Last 4 Years




County Wide Tickets By Year

























County Calls By Year




Types of calls for Service 2022-2025



Civil Evictions by Year – Town Of Windsor

- Civil Evictions can be caused by several things and are not always crime related; However, evictions are a quality of life, and standard of living issue for the residents, and property owners alike.



Notable Case 2024

On Saturday, April 27, 2024 at approximately 5:06 PM, Broome County Sheriff's Road Patrol conducted a traffic stop on Route I-86 West in the Town of Windsor. During the investigation, deputies located in the vehicle a spoon containing a white powdery substance that field tested positive for cocaine, along with a case containing loaded black Smith & Wesson M&P 15-22 .22 LR, an AR-15 style rifle with an attached 25-round magazine and another 25-round magazine full of .22 LR rounds.

Notable Case 2024

On Saturday, March 29, 2025 at approximately 7:21 PM, a member of the Broome County Sheriff's SRG unit observed two motorcycles traveling south on Main St. in the Village of Windsor without license plates. After attempting a traffic stop, the motorcycles failed to comply, attempting to evade patrols at a high rate of speed. The SRG patrol pursued one of the motorcycles throughout multiple roads the Town of Windsor and eventually into Pennsylvania. Eventually, the motorcycle returned to the Village of Windsor and traveled north on Route 79 before becoming disabled, at which point the operator, Kirk K. Wayman, age 25 of Windsor, NY, was removed from the motorcycle and placed under arrest. A switchblade knife was found on his person.

Notable Case 2025

On Sunday, March 30, 2025 at approximately 10:30 PM, a member of the Broome County Sheriff's Road Patrol observed a grey 2021 Mazda CX5 on Harry L Drive in the Village of Johnson City that had been reported stolen out of the City of Binghamton. The sheriff's deputy attempted to perform a traffic stop, but the driver of the stolen vehicle failed to comply, fleeing east through the City of Binghamton.

As the vehicle slowed, the suspect, Joseph T. Martino, age 33, jumped from the driver's seat and attempted to flee on foot. A pursuing Broome County Sheriff's deputy pursued on foot and successfully deployed a taser on Martino, who was then taken into custody.
