

- Village Of Endicott makes up roughly 6.74 % of the total Population


# Countywide Calls For Service 2022-2025












# Total Calls By Priority Last 4 Years




# County Wide Tickets By Year



















# Types Of Calls For Service By year




# Types of calls for Service 2022-2025



# Civil Evictions by Year – Village of Endicott

- Civil Evictions can be caused by several things and are not always crime related; However, Generally Speaking Evictions are a quality of life, and Standard of living issue for the residents, and property owners alike.



# Notable Case 2024

On January 31st, 2024, the U.S. Marshals Service notified Broome County Sheriff's Deputies assigned to the NY/NJ Regional Task Force of three murder suspects possibly staying at a residence in the Village of Endicott. The three suspects were wanted for a murder that occurred on January 20th in Norristown, PA, outside Philadelphia, PA. The violent incident involved a robbery, murder with a firearm and arson of a vehicle. Sheriff's deputies followed-up on leads and used information gathered to develop probable cause to obtain a search warrant for the residence, located at 1104 Monroe St. in Endicott. The search warrant was reviewed and authorized by a Broome County Magistrate and Southern Tier SWAT Team was activated to execute the warrant. The Southern Tier SWAT Team, along with Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force, U.S. Marshals Service, and uniformed members of the Sheriff's Office and Endicott Police executed the warrant around 7:20 pm. The three suspects were taken into custody without incident. The residence was a multi-family dwelling and other residences were evacuated as the warrant was being executed.

# Notable Case 2024

On August 21, 2024, the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a search warrant at 1005 Pine St. Apt 2 in the Village of Endicott. The target of the search warrant was Joshua Mazyck, age 30 of Endicott, NY, who was present during the execution of the warrant. During the search, the following items of evidence were located:

- 227 blue M/30 Fentanyl pills (24.6 grams)
- 1.4 grams of Crack Cocaine
- Pregabalin Pills, A Schedule V Controlled Substance
- A Loaded 9mm Ruger Max-9 pistol
- Scale and Cutting Agent Used to Distribute Narcotics
- \$160 of US currency

# Notable Case 2025

An Endicott man is facing multiple felonies after fentanyl and a ghost gun were recovered during an investigation by the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force (SIU). On January 30th, 2025, the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a search warrant at 4 Fillmore Ave. left side apartment in the Village of Endicott.

During the search, the following items of evidence were located:

- 17 blue M/30 pressed Fentanyl Pills
- A quantity of Fentanyl
- A Digital Scale used to distribute Narcotics
- A 9mm Ghost Gun with a Loaded Magazine
- \$296.00 in US Currency
