

Did you know?

- Car seats expire. Most car seats will expire after 6 years from the date of the manufacture. Check the stickers!
- Be careful when using secondhand used car seats or car seats purchased from garage sales or flea markets. The car seat may be unsafe if you do not know its history.
- Always follow the instructions in the car seat manual AND in your vehicle manual for proper installation and harnessing.
- Be sure to register your newly purchased car seat so you can be notified of future recalls.

New York State Law:

All children must be restrained in an appropriate child restraint system while riding in a motor vehicle until they reach their 8th birthday.

An appropriate child restraint system is one that meets your child's size and weight recommended by the manufacturer. Seat belts are NOT designed for children.

Fitting Stations:

Certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians provide free education and guidance about how to properly transport your child safely, focusing on proper selection and installation of the child safety seat.
