Rules & Policies

EFFECTIVE January 19, 2026

Welcome

Thank you for using the Broome County Landfill. To ensure a safe, efficient, and compliant experience for all users, please review and follow the rules below when using the **Residential Drop-Off Area**.

Before You Arrive

- Plan Your Visit: The landfill closes at 2:45 PM. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before closing.
- Unload & Exit: All customers must be completely unloaded and off-site by 3:00
 PM (grace window).
- **Secure Your Load:** All loads must be **covered and properly strapped** to prevent material from coming loose during transport.

Vehicle & Unloading Rules

- 1. **30-Minute Unloading Limit:** Box trucks (including U-Hauls), pickups with trailers, and stake body trucks are limited to **30 minutes** in the residential drop-off area.
- 2. **Vehicle Size Restrictions:** Box trucks, stake body trucks and trailers **over 15 feet in length are not permitted** in the residential drop-off area.
- 3. Clean Area Requirement: Do not leave debris on the ground.

Prohibited Materials

Do NOT place the following items in residential drop-off dumpsters: - Televisions and computers - Batteries - Air conditioners and dehumidifiers - Freezers and refrigerators - Tires - Hazardous waste.

Need help? Ask the clerk about **proper disposal options** for these materials.

Safety, Inspections & Conduct

- **Load Inspections:** This facility conducts inspections. Illegal disposal may result in further action under local or State law. Please cooperate with landfill personnel during inspections.
- No Scavenging: Removal of any materials intended for disposal is prohibited by local law.
- Traffic & Signage: Observe all speed limits, direction signs, and posted notices.
- Staff Instructions: All users must follow posted and verbal instructions from landfill personnel regarding disposal and placement of waste and recyclables.
- **Zero Tolerance for Harassment:** Harassment of landfill personnel will not be tolerated and may result in **revocation of landfill privileges**.

Additional Policies

- Vehicle Assistance: Broome County is not responsible for vehicles with mechanical difficulties. Any emergency towing is at the vehicle owner's risk.
- **No Smoking:** Smoking is **prohibited** on landfill property.
- Payment Methods: Cash or check only.
